TCU - American Indian College Funds

Deadline: August 1 at 5 PM (MTN)

Eligibility: Any Native American U.S. citizen that is a member or descendant of a state or federally recognized tribe with at least a 2.0 grade point average, and enrolled as a full-time student can apply for a scholarship.

Required Documents:

- Application
- Tribal Affiliation (ex. CIB)
- Transcripts (Official Not Needed)
- Digital Photo (Professional-looking)

Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Scholarship

Deadline: Unknown

Eligibility: Applicants to the NNOGC Scholarship Program's MUST BE MAJORING in subject matter central to the OIL AND GAS INDUSTRY, such as:

- Engineering (petroleum, mining, mechanical, civil, environmental, or electrical)
- Geology
- Marketing
- Accounting
- Natural Resource Management
- Business Administration
- Human Resource Management

Indian Health Service Scholarship

Deadline: December 15, 2022 - February 28, 2023

Eligibility: maintain your enrollment status as a full-time or part-time student throughout the academic year and be in good academic standing at all times, this means maintaining a minimum 2.0 GPA. You must also report your academic program progress and immediately report any problems or changes in your academic status to your Program Analyst.

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FASFA)

Deadline: October 1st

Eligibility: Must have financial need, as a U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen, and are enrolled in an eligible degree or certificate program at your college or career school.

American Indian Service (AIS)

Deadline: November 1 (*Enrollment Open September 1*)

Eligibility:

- Enrolled or will enroll as a matriculated student in a university, college, junior college or technical school located in the United States (incoming freshman accepted)
- Must be enrolled or will enroll with an accredited school
- An enrolled member of a U.S. Federally Recognized American Indian or Alaska Native Tribe, or descendant of a base roll member
- Undergraduate student with no more than 150-semester credits or 210 quarter credits (First bachelor's degree only, graduate studies NOT currently eligible)
- Full-time or part-time status – excluding non-credit courses (minimum of 6 credits)
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25 must be established and maintained after the first semester/quarter of college

- Essay
- Proof of Heritage
- Current Transcript
- Official Tuition Billing Statement
- Thank You Letter

Opportunity Scholarship FAQs

What is Tuition-Free College?

- Full tuition and fees covered at New Mexico public colleges and universities
- Includes part-time and full-time students
- For students pursuing credit-bearing career training certificates, associate degrees, and bachelor's degrees
- Available to all New Mexico residents*

*Per residency standards set by the New Mexico Higher Education Department.

Cobell Scholarship Vocational Opportunity

Q: How do I determine if I am eligible for the Cobell Scholarship Vocational Opportunity?

A: The Cobell Scholarship Vocational Opportunity is for any individual who has not yet earned a college degree and is enrolled or will be enrolling in a vocational credential, vocational certificate, or occupational license program (not including professional level or post-baccalaureate certifications). Vocational degrees typically are one year or less in duration, certify competency in a specific trade, or provide a license to perform certain occupations. If an applicant is uncertain about this degree level they should check with the institution or review the „What is a Career and Technical Education“ Fact Sheet at www.acteonline.org. Vocational programs will be verified prior to making final awards.
